Faced with the health, economic and social crisis caused by the pandemic, the European Commission became strongly mobilised and was able to offer many initiatives of support for the affected sectors. It was able, in particular, to offer an ambitious plan of European recovery and, beyond that, to give a strong political direction for 2021-2027, based on concrete new initiatives, centring around the environment, inclusion, the digital sphere and democracy. The subsequent intervention of the war in Ukraine also demanded new responses.

These priorities and concerns are driving the work of the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union in the cultural and audio-visual fields. They also pose questions for the rollout of a creative Europe, and the cooperation necessary between its institutional and civil society stakeholders.

The launch of the Creative Europe programme, that took place in a pandemic context of distance and uncertainty, did not allow us to find our way. This is why it seemed important to us, under the French Presidency of the Council of the European Union, to propose with the Forum for a Creative Europe, and linked to the Ministry of Culture, the CNC and the European Commission, a time of meeting and discussion to debate these changes and perspectives, together among stakeholders.

We would be delighted to count on your presence on June 8 and 9 in Paris.
